

# Laura Evans Taken By Death

Laura Evans, a resident of Salida for many years, died at 8:30 o'clock Saturday morning at her home, 129 West Front street. She had been in failing health for several years. Her condition was regarded as serious 10 days ago and her daughter, Mrs. Lucille Howell, was summoned a week ago from Salt Lake City.

She was born May 31, 1871 in St. Louis, Mo. Possessed of a charitable nature, she was generous to many persons in all walks of life. Her reputation for honesty was unquestionable and during the mining era miners entrusted her with large sums of money. She cared for many Salida persons during the flu epidemic in 1918.

Survivors besides her daughter are two grandsons.
